- School floats will line up along Dogwood Ave looping back to school access road. Parade order- Legion Color Guard – Band- 3rd thru 5th Graders by class walking- Royal Court- 12th-11th-10th-9th-8th-7th-6th floats.
- Public floats will line up along 8th street in front of the school and will begin after the 6th grade float goes.
- Parade will make one loop up 8th street west to Main street, then turn left on Dogwood Ave and return to the school for clean-up/dismissal.
- No school floats will be allowed to throw candy.
- Each class will walk behind their school float under the supervision of their class advisors. One to two students may be permitted on the float if they are characters in the theme of the float.
