

2020-2021 Onida Elementary School Supply List

Kindergarten

- 24 regular crayons (not jumbo)
- 20 - Pencils: regular size, sharpened.
- 6 - Glue sticks – regular size
- Spiral index cards 3.5x5 white, at least 50 cards
- 1 - Large eraser
- 1 - Scissors: round tip
- 1 - Small plastic school box
- 1 - Composition book: Mead Primary Journal
- 1 - Regular sized backpack – no wheels please
- 1 inch, 3 ringed binder with view window on front
- 10 sheet protectors, clear, top loading
- Package of 10 Crayola Mini Twistable crayons: basic colors
- 2 - Fine tipped Dry Erase marker-any color
- White board eraser or cloth
- 1 - Large canvas pencil zipper pouch with clear window (if possible) that is meant for 3 ringed binder.
- 1 set of headphones, not earbuds that are iPad compatible.

1st grade

- 12 - Plain pencils #2
- 1 - Pair of scissors blunted
- 1 - Expo marker (any color)
- 1 - Wash cloth/old sock to be used as eraser
- 1 - Small bottle of white glue and 2 large glue sticks
- 2 - Big erasers
- 1 - Wide ruled notebook (70 pages)
- 1 - Small school box (not large ones please)
- Backpack or school bag
- 1 - (1inch) 3 ring binder with view window on front
- 1 - Box of crayons (24 count)
- 2 - Folders with pockets
- 1 - Primary journal
- Headphones or earbuds

2nd grade:

- Headphones
- 1 -bottle white glue and 1 stick glue
- 1 - Box of 24 crayons
- 1 - pkg. #2 pencils (no mechanical)
- 1 - Pink eraser (no pencil top erasers)
- 1 - School box (no large ones)
- 1 - Pair of scissors
- 1 - Wide ruled notebook paper – no loose paper
- Backpack
- 1 - Pocket folder (to stay at school)
- 1 - Plastic pocket folder –hard cover (to take home daily)
- 2 – 1 inch 3 ring binders – white with view window in front.
- No trapper keepers, please.

3rd grade:

- 2 - Large glue sticks and White school glue
- Scissors
- School Box
- Package of #2 pencils –Sharpened (12 or more) (no mechanical)
- Pink erasers or pencil top erasers
- 1 red pen, 1 blue pen
- Markers
- White board markers
- White board eraser (old socks work)
- Colored pencils or crayons
- 4 - College ruled notebooks
- 2 – Composition Books
- 3 - Pocket folders
- Ruler – metric/standard
- Basic calculator
- Highlighting marker
- Headphones
- Backpack

4th Grade:

- 1 – 5 Subject Notebook
- 2 – Single Subject Notebooks
- 3 – Hard plastic folder
- 1 – Fabric zipper pouch (for art supplies – no boxes)
- 12 - #2 pencils (Sharpened)
- 3 – Erasable Pens
- 2 – Big pink erasers
- 3 – Glue sticks
- 1 - Bottle of white school glue
- 1 – Scissors
- 1 - Box of crayons
- 1 - Box of colored pencils
- 1 - 12” Ruler (metric/standard)
- 1 - Package of 4 white board markers
- 1 - White board eraser or sock
- 1 - headphones/earbuds
- 1 - Backpack

5th grade:

- 1 – Fabric Zipper Pouch (for art supplies – no boxes)
- 24 pack of colored pencils (crayons not needed, unless for art)
- Mechanical or #2 pencils
- 2 – Single subject notebooks
- 1 - 5 subject notebook for Mrs. Rausch’s class
- Pencil Pouch
- White Board Eraser or an old sock
- 2 – Pocket folders
- Headphones/earbuds
- 2 – Glue Sticks
- Scissors
- Erasable Pens
